I will be making a commitment to the student's success and I require the same level from you and your entire family. I will be charging 4 lessons a month. If all 4 lessons are not attended there are no refunds. This is to ensure progress and because my makeup policy was not being used correctly. I will do my best to accommodate, however 4 lessons a month will be charged. Three (3) missed lessons without valid explanations will be cause for terminating lessons.

Payment Policy:
